The second edition of Normative's <u>'Carbon Accountability Report'</u> reveals that 82% of sustainability decision-makers expect the importance of compliance to increase within their business, up from 40% in 2023. However, the survey, commissioned by Normative, found that of those respondents facing challenges internally, 53% say "a knowledge gap in regulatory requirements and ESG frameworks is a challenge."

Leveraging the existing carbon accounting platform, Normative's CSRD offering provides additional tools and capabilities to prepare, process and report on the over 1000 data points, addressing the knowledge gap evident in the commissioned study. These key features will provide a clear pathway for businesses to move away from compliance confusion towards competitive advantage:

- Streamlined submission: Businesses are required to collect vast amounts of data for sustainability reporting the 'Carbon Accountability Report' finds that 63% of sustainability decision-makers that value the timeliness and accuracy of data submissions have insufficient staff or technological resources to achieve this with regards to ESG reporting. Normative simplifies the data collection process, including Al-supported carbon calculations, ensuring complete audit trails and enabling cross-departmental reporting.
- Expert guidance: A team of GHG-protocol certified Climate Strategy Advisors simplifies the compliance process for businesses grappling with overwhelming legislative requirements and confusing terminology
- From compliance to lasting impact: 86% of sustainability decision-makers working for businesses where CSRD is relevant, believe compliance is a competitive advantage. Normative can deliver this lasting business and environmental impact, through built-in reduction planning that also identifies ways to cut costs and save energy, on top of the detailed scope 3 emissions calculations and features that help businesses catalyse reductions and resilience across the supply chain.
